This program will prepare you to go straight into the second semester of year two of the three years Diploma in General Nursing program. The cost of this bridging Program is K4,000. You can pay 50% upfront and the balance through pay deduction. After completing the Bridging program, you will be eligible to take up the Diploma in General Nurse Training which will be for only one and a half years (or three semester) to complete for the program.
